1. Show Information:

- A) For Championship classes riders will be notified by mail as to what divisions you have qualified to ride in.
- B) For Championship classes, you may only ride in one Dressage division and one Musical Freestyle division per horse/rider pair. For Western Dressage, Championship classes will be split into Intro tests 1 & 2; Intro tests 3 & 4; Basic tests 3 & 4; based on which division you qualified.
- C) You must ride the two highest tests of that division, except for 4th level and FEI.
- D) **Championship Fees:** \$60 per division (two tests), \$45 for Lead Line, 4th Level, FEI, and MFS; **Open Show fees:** \$30 per Class
- E) Office fee \$15. Make Checks Payable to: ECRDA.
- F) Entries must be received by the closing date. No phone entries. **Mail entries to: Nicole Tokarz, 5 Stanley Place, Jackson, N.J. 08527**
- G) No refunds after closing date, including acts of God, inclement weather or other emergencies.

H) Negative Coggins within 1 year required. Proof of EIV (Equine Influenza Virus) and EHV (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccination within 6 months required.

- 2. **Awards:** For Championship Show, Divisions will be divided Jr., Sr., Having Shown Above 2nd Level.
- 3. **Starting Times:** On the internet at www.ecrda.com after September 22nd Or call show Secretary Wed. or Thurs. prior to show from 7-9pm.
- 4. **Other info:** A) Footing— sand arenas. B) Classes to be held in large and small arenas. C) Warm-up: Indoor sand arena or outdoor grass. D) Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted. E) Food will be available.
