- 1. For Championships Classes riders will be notified by mail as to what divisions you have qualified to ride in.
- 2. For Championship classes, you may only ride in one Dressage division and one Musical Freestyle division per horse/rider combination.
- 3. For Western Dressage, Championship classes will be split into Intro Tests 1 & 2; Intro tests 3 & 4; Basic Tests 3 & 4; Level 1: Tests 3 & 4; based on which division you qualified.
- 4. You must ride the 2 highest tests of that division, except 4th level and FEI
- 5. <u>Championship Fees:</u> \$60 per division (two tests); \$45 for Lead Line, 4th Level, FEI, MFS, Prix Caprilli
- 6. Open Show Fees: \$30 per Class
- 7. <u>Office fee</u>: \$15
- 8. Make checks payable to: ECRDA

- 10. No refunds after closing date, including act of God, inclement weather or other emergencies
- 11. NEGATIVE COGGINS WITHIN 1 YEAR REQUIRED.
- 12. PROOF OF EIV (EQUINE INFLUENZA VIRUS) AND EHV (RHINOPNEUMONITIS) VACCINATIONS WITHIN 6 MONTHS REQUIRED.
- 13. Awards: For championship Show: Divisions will be divided Jr; Sr; Having shown above 2nd level; Starter rider Juniors are divided: 12 years and younger; and 13 years and over.
- 14. Starting Times: On the internet at www.ecrda.com after September 19. Or call show Secretary Wed. or Thurs. prior to show from 7-9 pm
- 15. Other information: a. Footing: sand arenas b. Classes to be held in large and small arenas c. Warm-up: Indoor sand arena or outdoor grass. D. <u>Hard hats must be worn at all times</u> when mounted. D. Food will be available.
